# DEALING FROM THE BOTTOM OF THE DECKS

The Board has approved to clean all of the decks and railings and repaint any chipped black, handrails throughout the summer. Most decks will be recoated (a larger undertaking) and some decks will be partially rebuilt. One deck will be totally removed from the building and rebuilt (52 A & C). It has shifted and is cracking.

We will give all of you plenty of information, direction, and time frames when we get nearer to actual work days. It will happen over the summer months. It has to be warm to resurface the decks. Stayed tuned.

### DRIP, DRIP...SPLASH

We have had two water heaters go out in the past month. Both had to be replaced. Water Heaters live from 10 to 12 years. Many of us replaced the original OPV water heaters in 2006-ish, when the old "Star" heaters all died within about 12 months of each other. Check your storage unit for water on the floor, a hissing sound, or drips around the base of the tank.

Lori H just had to have hers replaced. It was about \$875.00 for the tank and about \$160 to install. The installing people (many times different from who sells you the heater) get the city permits for you. Be sure that they agree to take your old heater away.
