SQUIRREL FEEDING

While we all love the natural quality of our OPV neighborhood, some of our woodland creatures have overrun our property. Two squirrels had taken up residence in one of our attics. (Critter Getter has removed them!)

We want to remind all neighbors that bird feeders are wonderful and acceptable. Squirrel feeders, open feeding or the encouragement of feeding squirrels is not. There is an abundance of natural food for these critters via our pine trees. Hand feeding or feeding stations teaches them to look to humans for food and lessens their desire/ instinct to take care of themselves.

Please be sure that your bird feeders are not open to squirrels or we will ask you to remove them. This is for everyone's safety and the safety of the "wild" squirrels.



ATTIC/ DRYER VENT REFITTING

OPV has 36 more attics to retrofit, clean and add mold retardant. This will begin soon. If your attic still needs to be done, we will call you and schedule your time. (This only includes upstairs units.)

We will do one building at a time and we really need you to try to help us with the scheduling. It will mean that workmen need access to your attic, through your master bedroom for about a day and a half.
