Last week, LO received some fantastic news! This email was sent to many participants of the OGLO Bridge proposal:

The Policy Committee for the OG-LO Ped/Bike Bridge Feasibility Study took the following actions,

Recommended the following next steps:

Take no further action on the proposed bridge alignments given the political realities with the recent withdrawal of the city of LO from the process and the current landing points are not supported by the communities at this time"

In plain English, Foothills Park is out of the woods for now!

But keep in mind, that Clackamas County did NOT amend their overall transportation policy, so it's not totally over and they will be looking for other possible locations between the Sellwood Bridge and Oregon City.
