OPV HAS MANY "WARM WEATHER" PROJECTS IN THE WORKS:

BLACK STAIR HAND RAILINGS

The railings will be removed, sanded, powder coated and returned. Please hold the white railings as you walk up and down.

COMMUNITY CEMENT PATHS AND STAIRS

A professional company will come through the entire community to power wash and remove the moss on the walkways. They will not be cleaning the patios or decks at this time. Please remove all pots on stairs and landings for this work. (Pots are not allowed on actual stairs. One pot may be on the landing as long as it does not inhibit access to the upper decks.)

PLEASE NOTE: DO NOT HIRE ANYONE TO POWER WASH ANY COMMON ELEMENTS ON YOUR OWN. ALL COMMON ELEMENT MAINTENANCE IS TO BE HIRED BY CMI OR THE HOA BOARD.

PLEASE DO NOT DIRECT OR CORRECT WORKERS WHILE THEY ARE ON THE JOB. PLEASE DIRECT YOUR REQUESTS OR CONCERNS TO ANY BOARD MEMBER. THEY WILL CONTACT THE SUPERVISORS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

Safe Sidewalks will be out to correct a number of issues of our ageing sidewalks. It will be REALLY noisy and dusty. Please use other pathways when they are working on yours.

In addition, we are having some sidewalk sections removed and re-laid.

DECK REPAINTING

An inspection of each and every upper deck has been completed and 14 decks need to be repainted. We are working on the scheduling as soon as possible.

You will be contacted directly and told what you need to do to your deck when painting commences. Dragging deck furniture over the deck is a main reason that some deck paint needs to be redone. Whenever possible, please lift deck furniture into place. Do not drag items.

POOL PARKING

The parking spots in the front left-hand side of the pool will be for VISITORS ONLY and will soon be painted to say as much. Please use your assigned parking spaces if you have been using those spots. While the pool and Clubhouse aren't open yet, summer brings friends and family to our community and they need a place to park. Please respect this request.

POP OF SUMMER

My Landscape Committee and I have a number of projects in the works. We have requested about \$6,000 worth of landscaping to be done over the next few months. This includes adding turf in a number of places, replacing dead plants, adding a French drain and adding color spots where possible.

OSWEGO POINTE CONDOMINIUM PATIO RESERVATION REQUIREMENTS

With much consultation with our property management, the clubhouse outdoor patio is NOW OPEN for gatherings in compliance with the Oregon Health Authority guidelines. These can change depending on covid county risk level.

You Must reserve your time on the sign up sheets posted on the patio bulletin board and follow these requirements.

- 3. No use of clubhouse restrooms and kitchen.
- 4. Remove all garbage and recycling.
- It is in everyone's best interest to wear masks and maintain Social distance.


