CLEAN YOUR HVAC OUTSIDE UNIT

While all of us are good at cleaning the inside filters of our HVAC units monthly, don't forget the outside too.

I cleaned every unit in mid-August, but now it is up to you to take care of them.

Use a soft brush, like a soft Swiffer brush, and lightly brush top to bottom on the backside of the outside condenser unit. The dust and lint really just roll off. Then clean the ends of the unit. This is a bit more difficult as usually it has a cage over it. But go slowly and you will get it done.

If you aren't sure about how to do this...call me and I will get you started!

Do not use water to clean the condenser. MBC
