

#### **NEW RULES FOR CLUBHOUSE USAGE**

The board is in the process of creating new rules for the Clubhouse. The main concept is that the Clubhouse is an extension of your private living room. With this in mind, it means using the Clubhouse for family parties, birthday parties, social gatherings with family members, or resident gatherings.

We are not insured for gatherings that support businesses (nonprofit or not) that accept money for their use. Our Clubhouse is not to be used for corporate, fundraising, or business social meetings. We are not insured for these types of events.

The Clubhouse is not an "event rental" space. It is for personal use by our residents.

There is also a finite number of people allowed in each room. Soon this number will be posted. The Fire Department decides this number. It's calculated on square footage.

Stay tuned for more information when the new rules are completed.

Dear Owners,

You will not receive a coupon book to facilitate your payments. Without the coupon books, you will be receiving a monthly statement approximately two (2) weeks before the payment is due. If you have an email address on record the statement will be sent to you via email. If you do not have an email address the statement will be sent to via the mail.

If you are already enrolled in the ACH program, you must log on to ClickPay and modify the monthly amount beginning on January 1, 2023. If you are not enrolled in ACH and wish to utilize this method of payment, please log into your ClickPay account, and sign up. If you pay through your bank's bill pay option, please make sure that the new amount is updated, along with the new address:

Oswego Pointe Village PO Box 60092 City of Industry, CA 91716.

If you do not use ClickPay or your bank's bill pay option, you will still be able to send a check as you previously have in the past. However, rather than using the coupon book you will need to wait until you receive the monthly statement until you make the payment.
