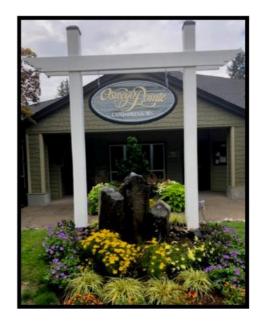

The board would like to remind all residents that you are required to have renter's insurance. Please refer to section 10.1.6 of the by-laws which states each unit owner shall be responsible for obtaining, at such owner's own expense, insurance covering his or her property not insured under Section 10.1.1, above, and against his or her liability not covered under Section 10.1.2, above, unless the Association agrees otherwise. Furthermore, the house rules of the Association require that homeowners provide a copy of their certificate of insurance to CMI so that it can be held on file in case of insurance claims in the future. POOL CHECKERS

By law, we have to check the pool chemicals daily. We are charged for every check we get, so for years, we residents, have jumped in and checked the chems five of the seven days per week. On the other two days, "Phil the Pool Guy" checks our records, checks the chems and the makes sure that the chems are where they should be! It saves us thousands of dollars per summer.

With that said, please consider being a Chem Checker. Pick a day of the week that you will do for at least one month if not more. Then you will need to check the chems on that day and record what you fine. It takes about ten minutes to check the spa and pool and record your findings.

YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED TO TOUCH ANY CHEMICALS OR ADD ANY TO THE POOL. YOU JUST NEED TO TEST AND RECORD.

Sandy and I have "tag teamed" our pool duty for years. We take all Sundays for the summer and trade off every other week. We cover each other if one of us is gone that day! You might want to get a friend and help out!
