### **Happy Birthday**



Phil the Pool guy will be submitting a \$20,000 upgrade for all of the pool equipment this fall. The vast majority of our equipment is original and starting to fail.


We will be leaving the back patio open for a little bit longer. Folks are enjoying it for now.

If it happens again, fines will be imposed. Please follow the neighborhood rules. It is only fair to the rest of us.




