CHANGING THE MODE AND BATTERIES ON YOUR HVAC REMOTES

Now that it is getting cold you may be wanting to change your HVAC from AC to heat. This is very easy to do. Just hold your remote in your hand, pull the remote front panel down until you see the "MODE" button. Slowly push the MODE button until the icon on the small screen looks like a sun burst and not a snowflake. Push the front panel back into place and turn the temp to one you like. Both remotes (if you have two) must both be on either heat or cold.

To change the batteries on the remote (if the screen is hard to see) just pull the front remote panel all the way off of the remote and two batteries will appear at the bottom of the remote. Replace both batteries and replace the remote front panel.

If you would like to donate any Kitchen towels, we would like them. Used is fine, torn or worn out, not so much! Please give them to Judy.


